## **DEC TO HOLD MEETING ON LAKE GEORGE FISHERY MANAGEMENT**

An informational meeting regarding management of the trout and salmon in Lake George has been scheduled by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC). The meeting will be held at 7 PM on Tuesday, March 10, in the main conference room of the DEC Office at 232 Golf Course Road in Warrensburg.

DEC fisheries biologists will present data and information on the lake trout and salmon populations in Lake George. Then the audience will be invited to participate in discussions on management options for Lake George trout and salmon fishery.

One possible option is to reduce the minimum length for lake trout from 23 inches to 21 inches. This, and other possible fishing regulation changes, can be reviewed on the DEC website at [www.dec.ny.gov/outdoor/51001.html](http://www.dec.ny.gov/outdoor/51001.html)
